Subject: Registration of Aviation Security Service Providers

1. Background.

ICAO Annex 17 amendment 14 Proposals of the Committee on Unlawful Interference with the assistance of the Aviation Security Panel (AVSECP), and Council action, in pursuance of Assembly Resolution A38-15, required the implementation of this amendment which includes landside security, security awareness training, and oversight of external security service providers.

2. Purpose.

In order for Suriname to fully implement the ICAO Annex 17 SARP's and the National requirements of CARS Part 13 art 13.4.9, 13.4.10, the CASAS has compiled procedures related to the application to be registered as a provider of Aviation Security Services.

3. Decision.

The purpose of this DDC is to assist handling agents wishing to provide aviation related security services.

It details the procedures to be followed i.a.w. the requirements of CARS Part 13.

The Government of the Republic of Suriname has mandated the CASAS to regulate all aviation related handling agents who as applicable will only be able to provide aviation security services on the basis of a contract with an airport operator, company or sub-contractor partnership after that company or sub-contractor has been approved and added to the list of companies as published by the CASAS.
