Subject: Emergency Restriction/ Prohibition Samsung Galaxy Note 7

1. Background.

The Civil Aviation Safety Authority Suriname is issuing an Emergency restriction/prohibition on the Samsung Galaxy Note 7 device based on Samsung's October 11, 2016 decision to stop manufacturing and selling Samsung Galaxy Note 7 devices, due to the inability to identify the root cause of the incidents related to becoming a fuel source for fire, possible ignition or dangerous evolution of heat caused by the device.

The CASAS has found an unsafe condition and that an unsafe practice exists and constitutes an imminent hazard to the safety of air transportation. By virtue of this DDC, the Samsung Galaxy Note 7 is considered a forbidden hazardous material.

2. Purpose.

This Decision Director CASAS provides Emergency Restriction/Prohibition to Samsung Galaxy Note 7 users and Air Operator Certificate holders.

3. Decision.

By this Decision Director CASAS, the CASAS is:

- Prohibiting persons from transporting or offering for air transportation a Samsung Galaxy Note 7 device, by either carrying it on their person or in carry-on baggage when boarding an aircraft, placing the Samsung Galaxy Note 7 device in checked baggage, or shipping it via air as cargo;
